Community Partnerships

Saint Paul School is partnered with Holly Hill Organic Farm in Cohasset for outdoor learning and science curriculum. The children planted organic box gardens outside of the school, grow and harvest organic vegetables used in school lunches, and compost their leftovers outside daily.

SPS also partners with the Weston Observatory and Boston College in the tracking and monitoring of world earthquakes through the school seismograph.

Notre Dame Academy has provided in-school enrichment to the SPS students by presenting their work done in the Neuroscience Club and Robotics Team.

Standardized Testing

The Boston Archdiocesan standardized testing results demonstrate that Saint Paul School consistently tests well. This national standardized test measures academic growth.

In addition to standardized testing, several SPS students are eligible to participate in the Johns Hopkins University Center for Talented Youth testing which identifies students who demonstrate superior academic performance. The criteria for eligibility for this international test is a score falling in the 95th percentile or above in standardized academic testing.



High School Preparation

Saint Paul School's academic program offers a strong foundation to prepare our students for high school.

100% of SPS graduates who apply to Catholic and private high schools are accepted. Our students have been accepted to Archbishop Williams High School, Boston College High School, Catholic Memorial High School, Cardinal Spellman High School, Dexter, Fontbonne Academy, Noble and Greenough School, Notre Dame Academy, Sacred Heart High School, Thayer Academy, Ursaline Academy, and Xaverian Brothers High School.

Seventh and eighth grade students receive specialized study and time management courses in addition to the skills integrated in the daily curriculum.

Saint Paul School incorporates the teachings of the Catholic faith in daily lessons.

SPS students actively participate in monthly Mass as well as on holy days of obligation. As part of faith formation, our students participate in several community service projects throughout the school year.
